

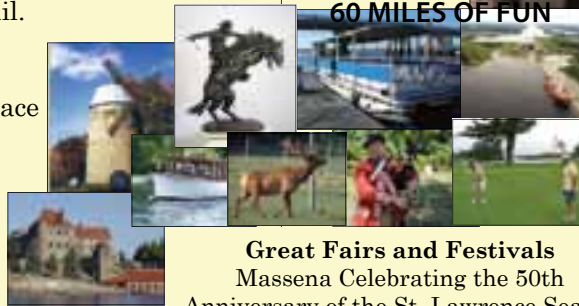

Seaway Trail Storyteller Sign Series Offer On-the-spot learning

Over 100 Great Lakes Seaway Trail interpretive signs along the byway, share the facts, legends and lore associated with the area. What better way to tell the stories of the byway than with an artist-illustrated series of signs all along the shores of Lake Erie, the Niagara River, Lake Ontario, and the St. Lawrence River?

In 2005, the U.S. Congress designated the Great Lakes Seaway Trail one of 'America's Byways' in the National Scenic Byway Program of the Federal Highway Administration. While the route was recognized for its unique natural landscape and historical significance, the Great Lakes Seaway Trail region is also noted for its diverse agricultural and architectural resources, historic

lighthouses, maritime heritage, industry and the accomplishments of inventive, artistic or gifted individuals who changed the world in some way.

Acclaimed wildlife artist and environmental interpreter, Bob McNamara, works with Great Lakes Seaway Trail community leaders and historians to create this beautifully designed and colorful series of signs.

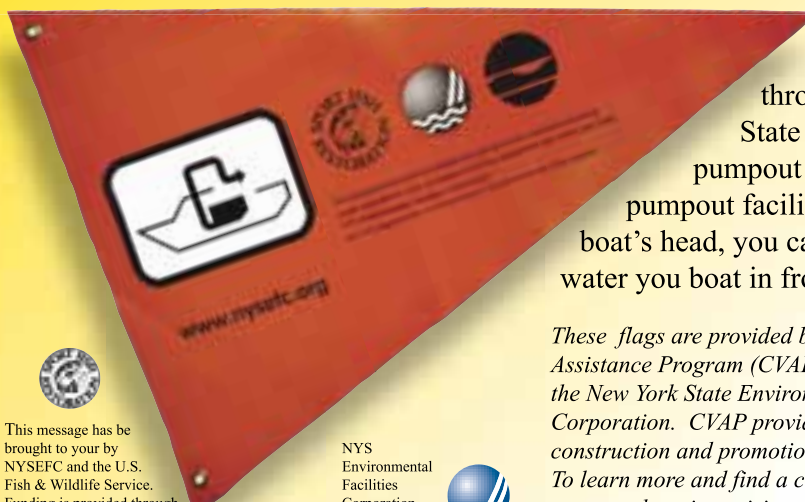
