Best for Experienced Bicyclist; make overnight reservation in advance.



The Great Lakes Seaway Trail is one of America's Byways and is recognized for its unique landscape, scenic freshwater coastline, and historical significance. 4 hours 48 miles to
- Day 2 Historic Dunkirk Lighthouse, Dunkirk NY
Stop at Frank Lloyd Wright's Graycliff Estate, Derby
Overnight in Buffalo
4 hours 46 miles to
- Day 3 Naval Harbor overlooking Buffalo Lighthouses
See Buffalo & Erie County Botanical Gardens, Buffalo
Overnight in Youngstown or Wilson
4 hours 42 miles to
- Day 4 Old Fort Niagara Lighthouse, Youngstown
Spend time at Old Fort Niagara, Youngstown
Overnight camping at Golden Hill State Park
2.5 hours 30 miles to
- Day 5 Thirty Mile Lighthouse, Barker
Oak Orchard Lighthouse
Overnight in Charlotte/Rochester
5 hours 68 miles to
- Day 6 Charlotte Genesee Lighthouse, Rochester
Take in Seabreeze Park
Overnight in Sodus Point
3.5 hours 38 miles

- Day 7 Sodus Point Lighthouse, Sodus Point
Bring your GPS & do some GeoTrail geocaching along the way
West Pierhead Lighthouse, Oswego
Overnight in Oswego
3.5 hours 40 miles
- Day 8 Selkirk Lighthouse, Pulaski
Stop at Seaway Trail Discovery Center, Sackets Harbor
Overnight at Youth Hostel, Cape Vincent
6.5 hours 75 miles
- Day 9 Tibbetts Point Lighthouse, Cape Vincent 1.5 hours 20 miles
To Grass Point State Park, boat to Rock Island Lighthouse
