## Seaway Trail Camping & RV Fact Sheet

The Great Lakes Seaway Trail — 504 miles of byway along Lake Erie, the Niagara River, Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence River — one of America's Byways and a National Recreation Trail. Those who enjoy camping and traveling by RV will find the information below helpful for enjoying the Seaway Trail.

### Great Lakes Seaway Trail travelers find:

- 40 State Parks along the shoreline
- Hundreds of privately-owned campgrounds with cabins, cottages and sites for tents, campers and RVs; some with boat slips/marinas
- Pristine fresh water for swimming, boating, diving, fishing
- World-class fishing and tournaments
- Boat launches for your craft and boat/yacht tours by admission
- Fine charter and dive services Trailwide
- White water for kayaking
- Unique views and photo opportunities:
  - the world's ocean-going freighters on the St. Lawrence Seaway
  - beautiful sunsets over Lake Ontario
  - migrating hawks and songbirds along the Seaway Trail's flyway
  - waterfalls, sailboats on the harbor, and other scenic vistas
  - bluffs, dunes, other natural areas filled with wildlife and wildflowers
  - tall ships that visit the Trail's ports
- Fascinating attractions: historic, maritime, cultural, architectural, agricultural, recreational (also see Outdoor Recreation Fact Sheet):
  - 28 historic lighthouses, forts, castles, Frank Lloyd Wright sites, Olmsted parks, farm markets, museums, comedy playhouses, theatre
  - divers find thousands of underwater shipwrecks to explore
- Some sections of Robert Moses Parkway along the Niagara River and the Lake Ontario Parkway along Lake Ontario have low-height bridges. Watch for signage showing height limitations of 10' to 14'. Commercial RV traffic is also restricted in places. General height restriction is 13.5'.

- According to New York State Department of Motor Vehicles, generally, the maximum allowable length for an RV is 45'. If the RV is 40-45' long, the wall-to-wall turning diameter may not exceed 90'3". If the RV is towed, the maximum length in combination with a towing vehicle is 65' for most highways. General width restriction for RVs is 96-102' in most cases where traffic lanes are 10 or more feet wide.
