

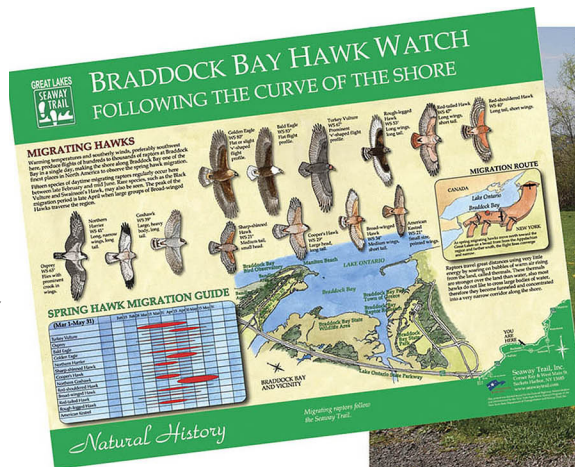
# Great Lakes Seaway Trail Birder's Checklist

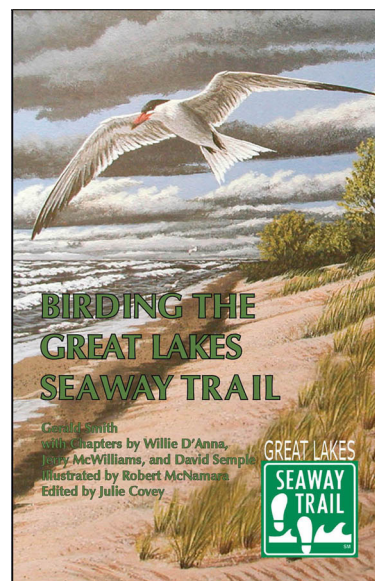
